WHAT IS THE POLICE ATHLETIC LEAGUE BALL

The Police Athletic League Ball is a fundraising event that directly benefits the Erie Police Athletic League (PAL).

WHAT IS PAL

The Police Athletic League (PAL) program of Erie is a non-profit organization that is supported and staffed by the Erie Police Department, Erie County Sheriff's department, Gannon University Police Department and Erie County Detectives. Officers interact with, coach, mentor and teach students after school. Programming is tailored around the interests and curiosity of kids in concert with the GEARS after school programming standards.

PAL'S MISSION

PAL is based on the conviction that young people, if they are reached early enough, can cultivate strong positive attitudes towards/with law enforcement in their journey through life, with the goal being that of maturity, inclusiveness, and good citizenship.

Studies have shown that if a young person engages and interacts with law enforcement on the ball field, gym, or classroom, they will likely understand and respect the laws that police officers enforce. Such respect is beneficial to the youth, the police officer, our neighborhoods, and the business community.

HOW WE'VE GROWN

2016-17: PAL began in one school, Pfeiffer Burleigh, with 35 students participating. Later that year, Trinity Community Center was added. The first annual summer commuter camp at Gannon University hosted 65 kids. 2017-18: PAL added McKinley Elementary to the program. The 2nd annual summer camp at Gannon grew to 145 campers from the combined three locations.

2018-19: PAL added four new elementary schools including Harding, Jefferson, Lincoln, and Diehl. The third annual summer camp at Gannon grew to nearly 200 kid campers. 2020-21: PAL was run in six schools and one community center, serving more than 300 students throughout the city of Erie.

2022-23: Erie PAL, after 2022, added 3 more separate locations to the program, bringing our total number to 19 different entities that Erie PAL currently serves throughout the city of Erie. Erie PAL currently serves approx. 1200 kids throughout the city of Erie. Erie PAL also added 1 additional summer camp, bringing our total of 4 summer camps run by our officer's throughout the summer months, including our summer program. 2023-24: This was a ground breaking year for Erie PAL We added another Perry Elementary school to our program and growing our numbers to approximately 1600 kids. Along with the addition to adding Perry, we took our first overnight trip with taking 41 kids to Washington DC. The kids were able to view all of the historical monuments the first night. From there, we took the kids to the Holocaust Museum and the National Law Enforcement Museum. Along with our DC trip, we took a small group of our older kids to New York City for a 2-night trip. When we arrived in NYC we took the kids to their first Broadway showing of Aladdin. The next day, we took a walk to go see Times Square, the Today show, and sight seeing around NYC. We took the kids to the 9/11 Memorial Museum. From there, the kids then got the opportunity to get on a boat to see the Statue of Liberty and go to Ellis Island to learn a little more about their family history. We wrapped up this historical trip with a tour of NYPD's command station.


